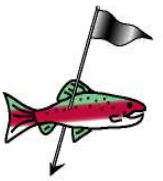

2009 Project(s) Update:

The back 9 restroom project is nearing completion. The sewer line (from Colorado Blvd. to the 14th tee box) is in place and the building foundation is finished. Construction on the building walls is finished and the trusses have been set. The roof installation is set to begin next week. *Weather permitting*, we hope to have the project completed and new cart paths in place before we begin to get busy with play.

The new bridges on hole #15 are also in process. Both crossings on hole #15 will be replaced. The second crossing (through the trees) is finished with the bridge in place and the cart path poured. Once the hand railing is attached, the new bridge will be up to code and usable. The concrete through the middle of the opening (old crossing) will soon be removed allowing the creek to flow much more smoothly. The first crossing will be next on the list of 2009 projects - once the bathroom and other bridge project are completed.
